We also perform environmental and remediation work, including asbestos abatement, lead paint remediation, and reclaiming natural resources through soil and groundwater remedial action. Additionally, we offer supplemental fieldwork such as conduction monitoring and maintenance of remediation equipment, to environmental consulting firms.

In our nearly 20 years in business, MYC has contracted with Naval Air Station Fallon (Nevada) and Naval Air Station North Island Coronado (California), as well as the New Mexico Environmental Department Hazardous Waste Bureau (NMED-HWB) and Petroleum Storage Tank Bureau (NMED-PSTB).
